Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Students are permitted to get placed in multiple companies and they can choose the best among them.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Special programs are organized to train the students for various competitive examinations like GATE, TANCET, UPSC exams etc. • Management has announced various scholarships to the students who have secured good marks and cut-off in higher secondary examination. • Opportunities are created for the students to learn Multidisciplinary Courses, Certification courses, One credit courses, Liberal arts courses and other languages. • Company specific courses are planned to be incorporated in the new regulation R2024 in addition to online courses like NPTEL, MOOC and Coursera. • Faculty members are encouraged to attend training programs with monetary benefits. • Club activities are planned on Saturdays to inculcate the students with team building ability, leadership skills, coding practices, communication development and innovation.
Resolution	The Council appreciated the action taken on the suggestions made by the Council in its previous meeting.
Item – 02	Academic Schedule 2023-2024 (Even Semester)
Discussion	Academic Schedule was prepared based on the guidelines of UGC/ AICTE/ Anna University. The same will be followed in the Academic Year 2023-2024(Even Semester).
Resolution	It was resolved to approve the academic schedule proposed by the college. A copy of the academic schedule is enclosed in Annexure-I
Item – 03	Discussion on Curriculum and Syllabi recommended by Board of Studies of UG & PG programme for the academic year 2023 – 2024 (Even Semester)
Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The curriculum and syllabi of all UG & PG programmes under Regulation 2020 and the minutes of Board of Studies for the academic year 2023 – 2024 (Even Semester) were displayed and discussed. • Honors and Minor degree courses are introduced in R2020. The details and discussion of the courses are as follows:

(i) For B.E./B.Tech. Honors; Specialization shall be in the same discipline :

1. The student should have earned additionally a minimum of 18 credits from a specified group of Professional Electives of the same programme.
2. The student should have passed all the courses in the first attempt.
3. The student should have earned a minimum of 7.50 CGPA.

(ii) B.E Honours:

1. The student should have taken additional courses from more than one vertical of the same Programme and earned a minimum of 18 credits.
2. He / She should have passed all the courses in the first attempt.
3. The student should have earned a minimum of 7.50 CGPA.

(iii) B.E. Minor in other specialization:

1. The student should have earned additionally a minimum of 18 credits in any one of the verticals of other B.E programmes
2. Out of these 18 credits students can earn a maximum of 6 credits through online mode (SWAYAM platform), as approved by Centre for Academic Courses.

Honors and Minor degree courses

1. B.E./ B. Tech. (Hons) Specialization shall be in the same discipline, B.E / B.Tech. Honors and B.E./ B.Tech. Minor in other specialization degree will be optional for students.
2. For the categories (i) to (ii), the students shall be permitted to register for the courses from the Semester V ,provided the students has earned a minimum CGPA of 7.50 until Semester III and has cleared all the courses in the first attempt.
3. For the category (iii); the students will be permitted to register the courses from Semester V; provided the marks earned by the students until Semester III is CGPA 7.50 and above.
4. If a student decides not to opt for Honors, after completing certain number of additional courses, the additional courses studied shall be considered instead of the Professional Elective courses, which are part of the curriculum. If the student has studied more number of such courses than

	<p>the number of Professional Elective courses required as per the curriculum, the courses with higher grades shall be considered for the calculation of CGPA. Remaining courses shall be printed in the mark sheet; however, they will not be considered for calculation of CGPA.</p> <p>Registration of Professional Elective courses from Verticals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Professional Elective Courses will be registered in Semesters V to VIII. These courses are listed in groups called verticals that represent a particular area of specialization / diversified group. The student should have earned additionally a minimum of 18 credits in any one of the verticals for obtaining B.E./ B.Tech. Honors with specialization in the same disciplines.
Resolution	It was resolved to approve the Honors and Minor degree courses as per the discussion and drafted rules and regulations, the curriculum and syllabi of all UG & PG programme under Regulation 2020 and minutes of Board of Studies for the academic year 2023 – 2024 (Even Semester). The minutes of Board of Studies are given in Annexure-II
Item – 04	Result statistics of Semester End Examinations for the academic year 2022 – 2023 (Even Semester)
Discussion	The result statistics of Semester End Examinations was taken up by the academic council for discussion and was analyzed.
