Faculty:

- Principal / Director of the institution is not eligible (Ph.D. not in relevant escipline) as per AICTE norms. Eligible Principal / Director should be appointed by 30th June, 2008.
- Cadre ratio not maintained as per AICTE norms.

Others:

Previously communicated deficiencies partially complied.

The mandatory discosure in prescribed format if not hosted on the weisite should be Note: hosted by 31st May, 2008, failing which action would be initiated as per the rules and regulations of AICTEincluding No Admission / Withdrawal of approval.

The institution is required to submit two copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosur and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Webste www.aicte.ernet.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31st August 2008 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2008-09. It may be noted that all the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report along with requisite processing fee by 31st August, every year irrespective of the period of approval.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favor of "The Member Secretary, IICTE", payable at New Delhi. In the disence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be enterprised. Following the Compliance report the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random in prection without any prior notice.

The approval if granted after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfillment of the following general conditions:

- That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and formeeting recurring expenditure.
- 2 (a) That the admissionshall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICE.
 - (b) That the admission shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
 - (c) That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/ assessment of students shall be inaccordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
 - (d) That the Institutionshall not allow closure of the Institution discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
 - (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institutionover and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the founcil, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be intiated against the Institution
 - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/ or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of appraval shall be initiated against the Institution
 - That the Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/ campus and / or in the name of the Institution without prior permission/ approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution
 - (h) The institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/ campusander any circumstances. In case any volation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawalof approval shall be initiated against the Institution

- That the institution hall operate only from the approvellocation, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
- That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as precribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria pescribed by the Council from time time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ grardians of students in any form.
- That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open forinspection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- That the Director/ trincipal and the teaching and ofter staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per thenorms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7. (a) That the instrution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
 - (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on tost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as an when changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosures on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31st August 2008 for the current year.
 - (e) That if Tednical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/ α misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal d AICTE approal.
- That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9 That a library shall beestablished with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AITTE norms.
- 10 That a computer center with adequate number of terminal, Printers etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
- AICTE may carry out andom inspections round the year or verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- 12 That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, violation of norms and sandards, mal-practices etc.
- 13 That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grantin-aid form the Central or State Government.

- That in the event of a student/candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant stat. The entire file collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing of notmore than Rs. 100/- (Rupees One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / thiversity to the student /candidate withdrawing from the programme. If would not be permissible for institutions and Universities to retain the School/Institution Leaving Certificate in original to force retention of admitted students (see Public Notice ACTE/DPG/03(01)/2008).
- 15 That the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme fourt of India in Writ Petition No. (C)656/1998. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the institutions, the Council shall take the appropriate action withdrawa of approval.
- 16 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council through various notifications in media including AICTE official website (www.aicteernet.in), from time to time.
- 17 In the event of non-compliance by the K S R College of Engineering, Vavithottam, Tiuchengode , Tamil Nadu with regark to guidelines, norms and conditions prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval or recognition, without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawalwould solely be that of K S R College of Engineering, Varithottam, Tiruchengode , Tamil Nadu
